CALL for SUBMISSIONS - Astronomy Award (€ 2,000)
Under the auspices of Greifswald's Lord Mayor Dr. Stefan Fassbinder.

Again in 2021, the charitable association Observatory Greifswald e.V. at the University of Greifswald, Germany wants to appoint the "Johannes Conrads Award for Astronomy & Aerospace" to the most excellent theoretical paper and practical work from astronomy and aerospace in the Baltic Sea area.

We are calling upon young persons with a Bachelor's degree, (Ph. D.) students and postdocs to submit their top-class expert and seminar papers, photo documentations, construction papers of their own astronomical tools, or similar. Interdisciplinary works are welcome, too. Accepted will be proposals that had been created between January 01, 2020 until October 31, 2021 (inclusively).

The presented proposals requiring a high degree of scientific or professional excellence will be assessed by astronomy experts from the Baltic Sea area. The best proposal will be awarded with the € 2,000 "Johannes Conrads Award for Astronomy & Aerospace".

Closing date is Sunday, October 31, 2021 at 24:00 hours. Recourses to legal processes are excluded, i.e. the judges decisions are final. We are thankful for the kind support of Peter-Warschow-Sammelstiftung Greifswald.
